Who is eligible for NTHS?



- ◆ Must have 2 letter-graded credits in 1 program area
- ◆ An industry-level certification in the nominated area may fulfill ½ credit per certification, up to a max of 1 credit
- ◆ Hold a 3.5 or higher GPA for CTE classes
- ◆ Have a 3.0 or better overall GPA
- ◆ Involved in a student or community activity
- ◆ Nominated by a CTE Teacher



How do I become a Member?



- ◆ Nominated by a CTE Teacher
- ◆ Complete the admission requirements
- ◆ Approved by a review committee comprised of 5 adults from the school and the community

This process takes place in the spring.
