

Alcohol Testing at GFC Dances

Students attending dances at Central High School will be tested for alcohol. Recent surveys indicated that the problem of drug and alcohol use in Grand Forks continues to be a serious issue. Our intent is to provide a safe and fun activity that is drug and alcohol free.

Three PAS (Passive Alcohol Sensor) devices will be used to check students before they enter the dance. Upon entering the dance each student will speak into the testing device. If alcohol is present, the device will indicate so and the student will be dealt with privately.

Students who test positive will have parents contacted. Consequences for breaking the alcohol or drugs rule will include a three-day out of school suspension, a citation by the police, and extra curricular suspension.
