

## SGT MARCHING TEST

To begin the evaluation the cadet will report into the grader with their cadet rank and name. They will Salute and state "Sir, Maam, Cadet CPL (insert last name here) is prepared for my sergeant marching evaluation."

The cadet will be instructed by the grader when to begin.

A cadet must have a minimum of four (4) cadets for their test.

One major or two minor mistakes are allowed.

Major Mistakes:

Command given on the wrong foot

Command omitted or added

Commands out of sequence

Minor Mistakes:

Command Voice

Not staying centered on the element

Not staying in control of your element

**The test will be graded by a Staff Member, Company Commander, Platoon Leader, Platoon Sergeant, or the AI or SAI.**

**A cadence may be given to keep your element in step. Depending on the location you are marching your test, the command rear, march may be given to keep from hitting a wall. (Make sure you ask about this before starting your test.)**
